Terminology:

Active obedience: actively obeying the Law

Passive obedience: submitting to authority, particularly in Jesus' death

Atonement: reconciliation for wrongs, paying the penalty for wrongs

Substitute: Christ died instead of us; he is our substitute

Substitutionary atonement: Christ died for man, in man's place, taking his sins and bearing them for him. The bearing of man's sins takes the punishment for them and sets the believer free from the penalty of the law: The righteousness of the law and the holiness of God are satisfied by this substitution.

Propitiation: Appeasement; to take away wrath and to get back into favor with God

Expiation: Wiping out the guilt of sin
