The Analogy of Faith was a key principle of interpretation taught by the Reformers. It teaches that Scripture should interpret Scripture. It can be summed up as "*all Scripture is in agreement and will not contradict itself.*"

Our Confession states, "The infallible rule for interpreting Scripture is the Scripture itself. Therefore, when there is a question about the true and full meaning of any part of Scripture (and each passage has only one meaning, not many), it must be understood in the light of other passages that speak more clearly. 2LCF (1689) 1.9
