Believers may be tempted to seek "something more than Christ" for assurance, things such as Col 2:8,16,18,23 but believers are "made complete" in Christ (Col 2:9-10) positionally, as we have studied in recent weeks, and personally, that we may experience the fulness of the Christian life (2 Pet 1:3-11).
